The answers to Q1-10 are:

- 1) The difference between Simple and Compound time signatures. Simple time signatures relate to the crotchet. Compound time signatures relate to the QUAVER
- 2) The 'Stave' consists of FIVE lines
- 3) An 'Interval' is the **DISTANCE** between two notes
- 4) The **DOMINANT** is the technical name for the fifth note of the scale
- 5) An ACCIDENTAL is the name given to an added sharp or flat in music
- 6) DOLCE is an Italian musical term which translates to mean 'sweetly'
- 7) **CRESCENDO** is an Italian musical term which translates to mean 'getting louder'
- 8) There are **FOUR** instruments in a string quartet
- 9) A **SYMPHONY** is a large orchestral piece
- 10) Notes written above or below the stave may use a LEGER LINE
