6) This Italian musical term translates to mean 'light, delicate'

LEGGIERO

7) A percussion instrument which has three sides

TRIANGLE

8) This Italian musical term translates to mean 'walking pace'

ANDANTE

9) The name given to a group of eight instrumentalists

OCTET

10) Another percussion instrument. This one has metal keys

GLOCKENSPIEL

11) This short Italian word translates to mean 'Not'

12) Indicated by the double bar line
